

STUDY LATIN ONLINE!

ECCLESIASTICAL LATIN A ONLINE

Scholars and students of canon law, medieval studies, late antiquity, patristics, liturgy and church music, or simply anyone who wishes to refresh their Latin, will be interested in a new course in Ecclesiastical Latin offered online by Australian Catholic University. The student will be introduced to the Latin of the church using actual biblical texts and other sources from the Church Fathers. Online drills and exercises allow students to proceed at their own pace with continual feedback from the course presenter. The course is being offered at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels, and is also available to students who are not enrolled for degrees at ACU or are enrolled at other institutions.

A third advanced unit (Ecclesiastical Latin C) will become available in 2007.

THEO256/669 Ecclesiastical Latin A 10cp
Prerequisites: Nil

This unit aims to give the student the ability to read ecclesiastical Latin, through the study of original texts from biblical, patristic and medieval sources. These include selections from the Vulgate, canon law, the Liturgy, scholastic philosophy, Ambrosian hymns and papal bulls. The unit will cover units 1-12 of John F. Collins' *Primer of Ecclesiastical Latin*, which provides vocabulary lists, grammatical notes, drills and translation exercises.

THEO257/670 Ecclesiastical Latin B 10cp
Prerequisites: THEO 256/669 Ecclesiastical Latin A (or equivalent)

This unit builds on THEO 669 *Ecclesiastical Latin A* with the study of original texts from biblical, patristic and medieval sources. The unit will cover units 13-24 of John F. Collins' *Primer of Ecclesiastical Latin*, which provides vocabulary lists, grammatical notes, drills and translation exercises.
